Christine England has been receiving care from Beaumont for around 11 years.

Christine has **very poor eyesight** and **progressive MS** which means that Beaumont has had to ensure that Christine's care has been appropriately adapted as her needs have increased.

Beaumont carers help Christine get washed, dressed and prepared for the day each morning.

Recently, Beaumont adjusted its service for Christine and carers now also come to her home in the evenings to help her get ready for bed.

Alongside Beaumont's care service, Christine's husband Barry has a respite arrangement with their local authority. This means that someone comes and sits with Christine, ensures she takes her medication and prepares a meal. This allows Barry time to occasionally run errands and spend time enjoying his hobbies.

Barry said: "I like the fact that Beaumont regularly assigns the same carers to look after Christine. This continuity of care is great as it means that Christine has built up good levels of trust with her carers and they in turn understand her needs very well."

Barry added: "Beaumont's management support is also excellent. If there is something I need to alert them to, I know that there is someone for me to talk to and any issues will be actioned very quickly."

Barry's help, Beaumont's care services and the local authority's respite provision allow Christine to live at home with her husband, in familiar and loved surroundings.
